

Chartered Organization Voter Registration Program Small County Participation

Small County Participation

Participants in the Chartered Organization Voter Registration (Bounty) Program from the smaller counties listed below may submit smaller batches of voter registration cards rather than the minimum 100. Participating groups may submit a minimum of 50 or more registration cards if they are in a county in which Democratic registration was less than 20,000 as of October 18, 2010. Groups may submit a minimum of 25 or more registration cards if Democratic registration in the county was less than 5,000 as of October 18, 2010.

This course of action was adopted in response to concerns that small counties are not able to collect 100 registration cards as quickly as more populous counties. It was determined the disparity in registration card collection unfairly disadvantages small counties as funds are distributed in the order in which they are received. This rule was amended for the 2011 Bounty Program to encourage more participation in small counties and areas with traditionally lower Democratic registration levels.

Counties that are eligible to submit 50 or more registration cards include:
