



Each of California’s 53 Congressional Districts (CDs) are allocated from 4 to 11 District-Level delegates, based on population and presidential voting from the 2012 & 2016 elections. Using the same criteria, 26 of the 53 CDs are also allocated 1 Alternate each. Potential candidates for District-Level Delegates must submit **Form A**, pledging their support to a Presidential Candidate, during the filing period of **January 6** through **March 3**. Caucuses will be held April 19 in each CD where Democrats registered in the CD will be able to vote to slate delegates.
