Dear 2021-2023 DSCC Member of the 21st Assembly District:

The California Democratic Party held a Pre-Endorsing Conference for Assembly District 21 on Saturday, February 12, 2022. No candidate achieved the requisite votes to receive the CDP Endorsement. Thus, the CDP had no endorsement for the 21st Assembly District in the Statewide Primary Election.

Since the Primary Election was held and two (2) Democratic Candidates will be advancing to the Statewide General Election, pursuant to the CDP By-Laws, the Post-Primary endorsement process for the Statewide General Election will take place in the following manner:

Two Democratic Candidates Advancing to General Election: Endorsing Caucus to Be Held

If two Democratic candidates in a U.S. House, State Senate, or State Assembly election contest advance to the General Election and neither candidate received CDP Pre-Primary endorsement, the CDP Chair calls a Post-Primary Endorsing Caucus in the relevant district. (CDP By-Laws, Art.VIII, Sec. 3.h.(1).)

This Post-Primary Endorsing Caucus shall come to order on Saturday, July 23, 2022, at 1:00 p.m. I have designated CDP Regional Director Hene Kelly to conduct this meeting. Please try to arrive early to the caucus to check in.
