2025 ADEMs

- ADEM candidate registration will be conducted using an online form that can confirm eligibility automatically from the candidate's current voter registration status.
- ADEM voters have the opportunity to apply for credentials to access an electronic ADEM ballot between January 6 - January 24, 2025 @ 12pm. Must be verified as a registered Democrats in California, by January 24, 2025 @ 12pm.
- ADEM voter also have the option to register to vote at ADEM's in-person at over 40+ locations around the State, on February 22 or February 23 by a scantron ballot. Registration closes @ 6pm on February 23.

HOW TO RUN FOR ADEM DELEGATE

1	Candidates must be registered to vote as a Democrat by November 5, 2024 in the Assembly District in which they are applying to run.	×	
	Unless the candidate turned 18 or was naturalized after the Voter Registration deadline, and is registered to vote at the time of candidacy filing.	X	
2	Complete online candidate filing application (Dec 9- Jan 8, 2025) by 12pm indicating whether candidate is running for ADD <i>or</i> ADD and the Executive Board Position.	×	



HOW TO RUN FOR ADEM DELEGATE

If a voter is unable to register to vote by reason of citizenship status and would still like to run as a candidate, a separate
application form will be provided for eligibility verification.





Complete online candidate filing application (Dec 9th - January 8th) by 12pm indicating whether candidate is running for Assembly District Delegate (ADD) Delegate *or* ADD and the EBoard Position. Pay \$40 Filing Fee.





Deadline to withdraw a candidate's name from the ADEM ballot January 8, 2025 @ 6pm



WHO CAN RUN FOR ADEM EBOARD?

The position shall be offered to the highest-finishing ADD who also indicated running for Executive Board.

Each of the 80 Assembly Districts will elect <u>one</u> eligible Executive Board Representative.

CANDIDATE STATEMENTS

 Candidates will be allowed a statement of 2400 characters (including spaces). No edits are allowed once the candidate statement has been submitted.



 Candidates statement may NOT mention the name of any other candidate.


It is <u>not</u> required for a candidate to submit a statement




ADEM VOTER REGISTRATION



All ADEM voters must register online in order to confirm eligibility and receive a ballot




After completing the online ADEM voter registration form the system will generate an identification code

ELIGIBILITY CHECKLIST

Candidates

- Must be a registered Democrat in the AD they are running in by November 5, 2024
- Completed online registration form to be an individual ADEM candidate and voter
- Candidate will only need to complete one version of the registration form between Dec. 9, 2024 Jan.8, 2025

Voters

- Must be registered as a Democrat in the AD you are voting in on or before your Election meeting
- Completed online ADEM Registration form to be an individual ADEM candidate and voter
- Identification code must be entered onto your ballot



NOT FOUND ELIGIBLE?

If the information entered in the online ADEM registration form does not match a current registered voter record:

- It is recommended that all participants verify their voter registration online at https://voterstatus.sos.ca.gov/ or your County Registrar of Voter
- Your ADEM registration must match your voter registration.
- If the information you submitted is not found in PDI, you may continue your
 registration and receive an identification number to vote. You will be required to
 submit proof of registration by February 26, 2025 @ 12pm for your vote to be
 counted. (In Person Voting Only) Please email Adem@cadem.org for assistance.



HOW TO VOTE



There are two ways to vote in the 2025 ADEM elections:

- 1. In-Person Voting
- 2. Electronic Voting





ELECTRONIC VOTING

- To vote electronically in the 2025 ADEM Elections, voters must register by January 24, 2025.
- After January 24, 2025, ADEM Voters who choose to vote by electronic ballot will be mailed the online voting credentials via USPS on or before January 31, 2025.
- The online voting credentials will include the Voters ID Number, which was sent over email when they registered, and a unique password.
- Voter will use the ElectionBuddy link with the Credentials and login in to their ballot.
- After successfully logging in, voters will have the ability to select up to 14 candidates on the ballot. If you select more than 14, ElectionBuddy will not allow you to proceed.



ELECTRONIC VOTING CONTINUED...

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Credentials will be mailed to each ADEM participant's registered mailing address. No changes may be made.
- ADEM Voting Credentials WILL be distributed via mail ONLY, and not by email, phone, or any other means. This is to ensure that the information will be shared only with the participant through their registered address.
- If you do not receive your Voting Credentials, you must go to an In Person Location to vote using your original ID Number



IN-PERSON VOTING LOCATIONS



- In addition to the online voting system, there will still be the opportunity to vote at in-person locations.
- Any Democrat may vote at any location in the state if they so choose.
- Every in-person VOTING participant must have a participant code in advance to cast a ballot.





IN-PERSON VOTING CONTINUED...



- The voter can complete the in-person registration form on site to be verified in advance and provided a 10 digit code.
- In all cases of in person voting, the voter must pick from among the list of candidates for their particular Assembly District (based on their residence).
- If the voter is NOT verified in advance, then the voter must provide proof of verification by February 26, 2025 at 12 p.m. in order for the in-person ballot to be counted.



INELIGIBLE BALLOTING

Ballots will be voided if the ballot has any of the following issues:

- Missing participant identification code
- Incorrect or incomplete identification code
- Voting for more than 14 candidates on the ballot
- If two or more ballots are submitted with the same identification code, all ballots with that identification code will be voided. This includes Electronic and Paper ballots.
